

# Notice.

SEALED proposals will be received at the Office of the Clerk of Council, until the first of November next, for conveying water from the Spring known as Turknett's Spring, to the Market-House, in the City of Augusta, in pine logs, the diameter of which shall be at least fifteen inches, and the bars four inches.— The upper surface of the logs when laid down to be at least three and a half feet below the general surface of the ground. The course of conveyance from the spring, to be such as to intersect Broad-Street, between Marbury-street and Hawk's Gully.

Proposals may embrace the whole work, or separate proposals will be received for furnishing and boring the logs, naming the place where they will be delivered, or any other part of the work.
