## Chap. 369.

AN ACT for the transfer of certain documents of record from the county clerk's office in the county of Ulster to the county clerk's office in the county of Delaware.

PASSED May 26, 1879; three-fifths being present.

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Transfer of certain map and field-book authorized.

SECTION 1. The county clerk of the county of Ulster is hereby authorized and directed to transmit by express, or on the order of the clerk of the county of Delaware, to the clerk's office of Delaware county the original map and field-book of the survey of the township of New Stanford, made agreeable to an act for that purpose, passed April twenty-first, seventeen hundred and eighty-seven, by William Cockburn, commissioner, and John Cor, and William Cockburn, Junior, surveyors, and filed in the clerk's office of the county of Ulster as documents of record. The said map and field-book to be filed and kept in the clerk's office of the said county of Delaware as documents of record, and the expense of the transfer to be paid by the clerk of, and made a charge to, the said county of Delaware.

Expense of transfer.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

## Chap. 370.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and twenty-four of the laws of eighteen hundred and forty-nine, entitled "An act to incorporate the Syracuse City Water Works Company," and to amend the title of said act.

PASSED May 26, 1879.

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter two hundred and twenty-four of the laws of eighteen hundred and forty-nine, entitled "An act to incorporate the Syracuse City Water Works Company," is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

When company may enter upon lands, etc.

§ 12. Upon the payment or legal tender of the compensation determined as before provided, the said company shall be entitled to enter upon, for the purposes contemplated by this act, all the lands, waters, and real estate for which such compensation shall be paid or tendered as aforesaid, and to hold and use the same for the said purposes to them and their successors forever. If any person to whom any compensation shall be awarded, or who shall be entitled to the same by virtue of said award, cannot be found, or shall refuse to receive the sum awarded to him, then the said payment may be made by depositing the amount of said award to the credit of said person in such bank as may be appointed by said court; a certificate of such deposit, signed by the cashier of the bank, shall be published by said company in two newspapers published in said city, for four weeks successively, imme-

diately after said deposit. If the person to whom compensation is awarded, or who is entitled to receive the same as aforesaid, be under legal disability as aforesaid, payment may be made to his guardian or person appointed as aforesaid by the said court; and if said guardian or person appointed cannot be found, then by deposit in bank as aforesaid, which deposit or payment as aforesaid shall be upon such security and reinvestment as the said court may direct.

§ 2. The title of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "An act to incorporate the Syracuse Water Company," and the name of said company is hereby changed to the Syracuse Water Company.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

## Chap. 371.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-five of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to amend the statutes in reference to the collection of taxes in the counties of Livingston, Montgomery, and Oswego," so as to make the provisions of said act apply to the counties of Ulster and Ontario.

PASSED May 27, 1879; three-fifths being present.

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The first section of chapter sixty-five of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to amend the statutes in reference to the collection of taxes in the counties of Livingston, Montgomery, and Oswego," is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

§ 1. It shall be the duty of the county treasurers of the counties of Livingston, Montgomery, Oswego, Ulster, and Ontario, to collect annually all unpaid taxes upon lands in said counties levied for State or county purposes, in the manner hereinafter provided.

County treasurers to collect unpaid taxes.

§ 2. The second section of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

§ 2. It shall not be the duty of the county treasurers of the counties of Livingston, Montgomery, Oswego, Ulster, and Ontario, to transmit to the comptroller any account of unpaid taxes assessed upon corporations, or upon lands of non-resident, or of unknown owners in said counties, or any collector's affidavit in relation thereto; nor shall the comptroller credit the said treasurer of either of said counties with any unpaid taxes on lands or upon corporations, whether assessed to resident or as non-resident lands, but the whole amount of any State tax unpaid on property in either of the said counties shall be paid by the county treasurers of said counties to the treasurer of the State on or before the first day of May after the same shall have been assessed upon the real and personal property of said counties, retaining the compensation to which they may be entitled.

§ 3. The sixth section of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
